Membership can be secured through sending a cheque to the above address or by completing the standing order below. Note that under current tax legislation, gifts over €250 to Trinity College can be made tax efficient. Where a donor is a PAYE taxpayer, Trinity can claim the tax paid on the gross income. This significantly increases the value of the gift to the Association. For example a gift of €300 from a PAYE taxpayer paying tax at 41% is worth €508 to the Fund when Trinity successfully claims tax back from the Revenue. We will send qualifying donors the relevant forms for completion after the end of the tax year.
